Class A - Vegetables

- 1. 5 Potatoes 1 variety
- 2. 6 Runner Beans
- **3.** 6 Beans of any other variety
- 4. 3 Onions
- 5. 5 Shallots
- 6. 2 Courgettes
- 7. 1 Butternut Squash
- 8. 3 Carrots with foliage attached
- 9. 2 Leeks, untrimmed with roots attached
- 10. 3 Sweet Peppers or Chillies
- 11. 1 Cabbage
- 12. Longest Bean
- 13. Most mis-shapen vegetable
- 14. 2 sweetcorn cobs
- 15. 6 Salad Tomatoes
- 16. A spray of Cherry Tomatoes on the vine
- 17. A standard seed tray (37x23cm) of mixed vegetables
- 18. Any other vegetable not included in the above classes

Class B - Fruit

- 19. 3 Apples cooking or eating

Class C - Mixed Class

Class D - Flowers and Plants

- **30.** Miniature arrangement not more than 10cm high
- 31. Arrangement of flowers in a vase or container max 30cm high (fresh material only)
- 32. Arrangement of plant materials no flowers
- 33. An arrangement in an unusual container
- 34. A wrist corsage or a buttonhole
- 35. Dahlia 3 stems
- **36.** Collection of 4 stems of the same species, in a container
- 37. A favourite flower 1 stem in a vase. Any variety
- **38.** A home grown houseplant
- **39.** A home grown succulent



Class E - Crafts

- 40. A Hand knitted or crocheted item
- **41.** An item of patchwork
- 42. Any sewn item
- 43. An item of embroidery, tapestry or needlepoint
- 44. Any other crafted item

Class F - Art and Photography

(All items no bigger than 60cm x 60cm)

- 45. A painting any medium
- 46. A drawing in pencil or charcoal
- 47. A photo of the local landscape unframed
- 48. A photo of 'Wild' Alderton
- 49. A photo of your best friend

Class G - Baking and Preserves

- 50. A jar of jam made from any fruit

Rules and Information for Exhibitors

- 1. No entry to Village Hall during judging.
- 2. Exhibitors should complete attached entry form which, together with the entry fee, should be in the hands of the Show Secretary not later than **8pm Friday 9th September 2022.**
- 3. Exhibitors may enter multiple exhibits.
- 4. The entry fee is 50 pence for each exhibit.
- 5. Fees are payable for all classes except the Junior Section.
- 6. Class I, Junior Section exhibit entry is free. (under 12's)
- 7. Juniors entering adult classes to pay 50p exhibit fee.
- 8. Exhibits must be grown or made by the exhibitor.
- 9. All containers etc are to be provided by the exhibitor
- 10. The Hall will be open from **08.30 to 10.15am** on show day for staging exhibits.
- 11. Judging begins at 10.30am.
- 12. No entry to the public until 1pm.
- 13. Presentation of Trophies and Prizes at 2.30pm.
- 14. No exhibit may be removed before 3pm.
- 15. Any produce remaining after 3.30pm will be sold.
- 16. Disputes will be resolved by the show committee.
- 17. The committee will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit.
- 18. All proceeds will be used to support next year's show.
