Show Classes

Class A - Vegetables

1. 5 potatoes - 1 variety
2. 5 beans, all the same variety
3. 3 onions
4. 5 shallots
5. 2 courgettes
6. 3 carrots with foliage attached
7. 2 leeks, untrimmed with roots attached
8. 2 sweetcorn cobs
9. 3 peppers - chilli or sweet
10. 4 tomatoes of uniform size
11. A spray of cherry tomatoes on the vine
12. A plate of tomatoes - not red
13. A basket of mixed vegetables
14. Any other vegetable not included in the above classes
15. A wonky vegetable



Class B - Fruit

16. 3 apples - cooking or eating
17. 3 pears
18. 3 plums of any one variety
19. Soft fruit - on a plate not exceeding 20cm
20. Any other fruit not included in the above classes

Class C - Flowers and Plants

21. Miniature arrangement not more than 10cms high
22. A jug of garden flowers
23. An arrangement in a teapot
24. A collection of 3 or more fresh herbs in a jam jar
25. Dahlias - 3 stems of the same variety
26. Sunflowers - 3 stems
27. Roses - 3 stems of the same variety, named if known
28. A favourite flower - 1 stem in a vase
29. A table decoration
30. A home-grown houseplant

Class D - Art and Photography

(All items no bigger than 60cm x 60cm)

31. A watercolour painting
32. A drawing - any medium
33. A painting of a local scene
34. A photo of Alderton village life
35. A captioned photo to make us laugh
36. A weather photo



Class E - Crafts

- 37. A hand knitted or crocheted item
- 38. A hand sewn item
- 39. A machine sewn item
- 40. An item of embroidery, tapestry or needlepoint
- 41. A paper craft item
- 42. A reused, recycled or repurposed item
- 43. Any other handicraft item

Class F - Food and Drink

- 44. A jar of jam or marmalade
- 45. A jar of fruit curd
- 46. A jar of sweet or savoury jelly
- 47. A jar of chutney or savoury relish
- 48. A tea or malt loaf cake
- 49. 6 scones, sweet or savoury
- 50. 6 flapjacks
- 51. A plate of 6 homemade biscuits
- 52. A loaf of bread - made by hand
- 53. 3 eggs, identical
- 54. Any non-alcoholic drink
- 55. Any alcoholic drink



Note: Jars to be filled to a point not below narrowest part of neck.
Label to state variety and date only and placed on side of jar.
Plain lids or cellophane only please.

Under 12 years

Young person up to the age 16 years

Rules and Information for Exhibitors

1. No entry to Village Hall during judging.
2. Exhibitors should complete attached entry form which, together with the entry fee, should be in the hands of the Show Secretary not later than **8pm Saturday 7th September 2024.**
3. Exhibitors may enter multiple exhibits.
4. The entry fee is £1 for each exhibit.
5. Fees are payable for all classes except Class G and H.
6. Class G, Junior Section exhibit entry is free.
7. Juniors entering adult classes to pay £1 exhibit fee.
8. Exhibits must be grown or made by the exhibitor.
9. All containers etc are to be provided by the exhibitor
10. The Hall will be open from **08.30 to 10.15am** on show day for staging exhibits.
11. Judging begins at **10.30am.**
12. No entry to the public until **1pm.**
13. Presentation of Trophies and Prizes at **2.30pm.**
14. No exhibit may be removed before 3pm.
15. Any produce remaining after 3.30pm will be sold.
16. Disputes will be resolved by the show committee.
17. The committee will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit.
18. All proceeds will be used to support next year's show.
