# Show Classes

---

## Class A - Vegetables

1. 5 potatoes - 1 variety
2. 6 beans, all the same variety
3. 3 onions
4. 5 shallots
5. 2 courgettes
6. 3 carrots with foliage attached
7. 2 leeks, untrimmed with roots attached
8. 2 seetcorn cobs
9. 3 chillies
10. 3 sweet peppers
11. 4 tomatoes of uniform size
12. A spray of cherry tomatoes on the vine
13. A standard seed tray (37x23cm) of mixed vegetables
14. Any other vegetable not included in the above classes
15. Most mis-shapen vegetable



## Class B - Fruit

16. 3 apples - cooking or eating
17. 3 pears
18. 3 plums of any one variety
19. Soft fruit - on a plate not exceeding 20cm
20. Any other fruit not included in the above classes

## **Class C - Flowers and Plants**

21. Miniature arrangement not more than 10cm high
22. An arrangement of flowers or plant material in a vase or container - maximum 30cm high (fresh material only)
23. An arrangement in an unusual container
24. A collection of 3 or more fresh herbs in a jam jar
25. Dahlias - 3 stems of the same variety
26. Sunflowers - 3 stems in a vase
27. A favourite flower – 1 stem in a vase. Any variety

## **Class D - Art and Photography**

(All items no bigger than 60cm x 60cm)

28. A landscape painting – any medium
29. Any other painting
30. A photo – Stormy weather
31. A photo – Garden wildlife
32. A photo – Black and white
33. A photo – This brings me joy



## **Class E - Crafts**

- 34. A hand knitted or crocheted item
- 35. An item of patchwork or quilting
- 36. Any sewn item
- 37. An item of embroidery, tapestry or needlepoint
- 38. A piece of homemade jewellery
- 39. An item of 3D craft
- 40. A decorated card using any medium
- 41. Something new from something old
- 42. A well-being craft

## **Class F - Food and Drink**

- 43. A jar of jam made from any fruit
- 44. A jar of fruit curd
- 45. A jar of sweet or savoury jelly/jam
- 46. A jar of chutney or relish
- 47. A Lemon Drizzle loaf cake
- 48. 6 savoury scones
- 49. 6 chocolate brownies
- 50. A loaf of bread – made by hand
- 51. 3 eggs
- 52. Any non-alcoholic drink
- 53. Any alcoholic drink



Note: Jars to be filled to a point not below narrowest part of neck.  
Label to state variety and date only and placed on side of jar.  
Plain lids or cellophane only please.

## **Class G - Junior Sections (free entry)**

Under 8

- 54. Mr or Mrs Potato Head using a potato as the base
- 55. A fingerprint animal picture
- 56. A junk model made of recycled items
- 57. 4 decorated rich tea biscuits

Under 12 years

- 58. A Lego model designed by yourself
- 59. A model den in a shoebox
- 60. A recycled creation
- 61. 5 decorated cupcakes or cookies
- 62. A paper plane (winner will be the plane that flies the furthest)

Young person up to the age 16 years

- 63. A photo of a pet or animal
- 64. A4 size picture – any medium
- 65. A friendship bracelet

**Juniors are also very welcome to join in with the adult categories. Similarly, under 8's can enter the under 12's and under 16's categories.**

For the Antonia Black award. Design a cover for the next show. Entries via class teacher.

1. No entry to Village Hall during judging.
2. Exhibitors should complete attached entry form which, together with the entry fee, should be in the hands of the Show Secretary not later than **8pm Friday 8th September 2023.**
3. Exhibitors may enter multiple exhibits.
4. The entry fee is £1 for each exhibit.
5. Fees are payable for all classes except Class G.
6. Class H, Junior Section exhibit entry is free.
7. Juniors entering adult classes to pay £1 exhibit fee.
8. Exhibits must be grown or made by the exhibitor.
9. All containers etc are to be provided by the exhibitor
10. The Hall will be open from **08.30 to 10.15am** on show day for staging exhibits.
11. Judging begins at **10.30am.**
12. No entry to the public until **1pm.**
13. Presentation of Trophies and Prizes at **2.30pm.**
14. No exhibit may be removed before 3pm.
15. Any produce remaining after 3.30pm will be sold.
16. Disputes will be resolved by the show committee.
17. The committee will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit.
18. All proceeds will be used to support next year's show.
